- 1 bus monitor position open- advertising has been on-going
- Need for driver substitutes - advertising has been on-going
- 1 van driver position open for out-of-district - advertising has been on-going
- 1 driver is out recovering from heart surgery
- 1 driver is out with a shoulder injury

Fleet Update

- Out-of-district and homeless services are still necessary and always changing. Current needs have added a van driver position.
- Currently renting a handicapped van for out-of-district students. The State pays for the rental. We would be better to purchase our own and charge the state.
- Applied for 3 new buses: 1 special needs, 1 mini bus, and 1 regular bus.
- Waiting for the state approval for FY19 bus replacements.

Bus Garage

- Space is still a concern. Current situation has 2 mechanics working in 1 bay on 1 bus at a time. Two bays would be more effective.
- Heat in the garage has been addressed and guaranteed to not be an issue any longer. Making some building modifications to get more heat into our bay.
