Similar to what we have done for the last five years, half of our upcoming Winter/Spring course catalog will include pages from the larger district and is scheduled to be in mailboxes during the first two weeks of January. In addition to high school completion, college preparatory and computer classes, we are in the process of scheduling approximately 25 community enrichment classes to be offered from January through May. These range from fitness and outdoor recreation to hobby and informational content.

When answering the question, “How did you hear about this [enrichment] class”, 74% percent of Fall respondents residing in an RSU 16 town indicated they saw it in the brochure that was mailed to their home.

Academic Enrollments

We had four new students start in November, bringing our current enrollment to a total of 37 in academic, career and computer classes since July 1. Current students have aspirations toward Veterinary Tech, CNA, Early Childhood Ed, DOT, Medical and Tech related fields; others are in the exploration process and several have made visits to YCCC, SMCC, CMCC, MCHP, USM, UMA and Husson.

McKinney Vento Homeless Liaison

To date this school year, we have identified 10 McKinney Vento youth in our schools. These are students who lack a FIXED, ADEQUATE and REGULAR nighttime residence.
