Tick Season Continues

Even with the cooler weather tick season is not over. In fact, October is a peak time as ticks are looking for their last meals before winter. Typical symptoms of Lyme disease are fever, fatigue, headache, neck pain, body aches, joint pain and rash (only 20 to 50% of the time). Besides these symptoms children can also have loss of appetite, decline in school performance, mood swings, and speech and motor coordination may regress. Symptoms usually occur within the first month of infection but can show up months later. This school year we have had two students with unexplained joint pain and one with facial nerve paralysis that ended up being positive for Lyme disease. Don't forget to do tick checks after your outdoor fall fun.



PA'S HUSH PUPPIES

- 1 1/2 cups self-rising cornmeal
- 1/3 cup flour
- 1 1/2 cups sweet onions, chopped
- Buttermilk

Mix all ingredients with enough buttermilk to make a very thick batter. Let stand about 10 minutes. Drop batter from serving spoon into fresh hot oil. When they are floating and brown on the bottom, turn them. Cook until golden brown on all sides. Cook until fry in fresh oil at 350 degrees.
