## Just a few reminders....

- Recess- At 32 degrees OR colder, ALL students will be required to wear coats and pants (no shorts). At REALFEEL temperature of 0 or below, there will be NO outdoor recess. If students choose to play in the snow, this includes sledding, boots and snow pants will be required. IF you need help getting winter clothings, please contact Mrs. Kingsley in the office.

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- **Lost and Found:** Clothing found on the school grounds will be returned to the student immediately if it is marked with the child's name. It is important to mark coats, sweaters, hats, mittens, backpacks, lunch boxes and other items. Clothing or other items that are not marked are put in the Lost and Found box and held until claimed. All items that are unclaimed will be given to charity. Please have your child or you check the lost and found box regularly. Let's try not to have a mountain of clothes left!!
  - **Absence and Tardiness:** Helping your child establish good attendance habits is very important for school success. If your child is going to be absent or tardy, please inform the school by sending a note on the previous day or by calling the school as soon as you know. The school day begins at 8:00 a.m. All children should be brought to school prior to that time so they are ready to begin and in their classrooms at that time. Even a few minutes late is very disruptive as many teachers have started their morning routines. Thank you for your help and cooperation in this matter so we can ensure a successful school year for your child.

## **Safety Reminder to all Parents**

- The front door will be locked at all times(including arrival time)
- Parents/Guardians of K-5 students will drop off children out front, or at the main office or otherwise obtain pass if a specific situation requires them to go to their child's classroom
- Any parent/guardian, volunteer, visitor, worker traveling anywhere in the building will be asked to sign in and wear a pass (including breakfast and lunch)
- During school hours any parents/guardians coming to pick up their child will be asked to wait in the office while administrative assistant calls classroom to send the student down
- Please provide a note concerning changes in your child's pick up plans in the morning, phone calls to the administrative assistant during the day must be reserved for emergency changes only and made before 2:00.
