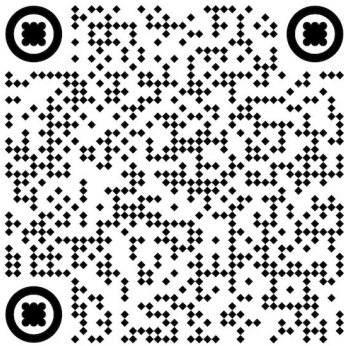

A Reminder About Lunch Changes

We made some changes to our lunch program this year. The first major change that we want to highlight is how meal selections will take place. Families will be making meal selections for the whole week in a google form. This form is located on our website, Facebook page, will be emailed and can be accessed via QR Code located on the website and Facebook page. A menu will continue to be posted monthly on our website. Selections for the upcoming week begin on Wednesday at 8am and are due by Friday at 9am. If you select meals for wednesday, they will be sent home with your child on Tuesday.

The USDA has approved the continuation of the Summer Meal Program through the month of December. This means all student meals will be free of charge until January 1, 2021. We are working to continue free meals for TVES beyond December 31, 2020, but we need YOUR HELP. Please fill out the application for Free and Reduced school meals that were mailed home. We are asking EVERY family to fill out and return the form so there is a chance for us to continue providing free meals to the whole school. Your help in this matter is greatly appreciated!

Creating peace posters gives students the chance to express their visions of peace and inspire the world through art and creativity. This year's Peace Poster theme is "Peace Through Service."

All submissions are due to the Deerfield Valley Lions Club by 4 PM October 30, and must include a parental signed form with the entry. One entry per student. Please contact CB for registration & drop off venue.

Artwork must not be smaller than 13 inches by 20 inches, no larger than 20 inches by 24 inches, and on flexible poster board material. All media is accepted. Charcoal, chalk, and pastel entries must be treated with fixative spray to prevent smearing. No 3-D entries (nothing glued or attached to the artwork), and NO use of lettering, numbering or words can be used in the artwork. The artist's signature may be placed on the back of the poster only.

Cash prizes will be awarded for the first, second, and third place posters; \$50 first prize, \$25 each for second and third. Our first prize winner will be submitted to Lions International District 45 for further judging and potential prizes up to the International level.
