## Calendar Changes

## TRAVEL & QUARANTINE



### UPDATE!

Thanks to the hard work and sacrifices of many Vermonters, our COVID-19 numbers have leveled out for now.

- For the period from December 23 – January 2, one household may gather with one other trusted household. That is a maximum of two households gathering during this period.
- Staying home and with people you live with is still the lowest risk.
- If you do gather, the Health Department strongly encourages getting tested 7 days afterwards. If you gather with anyone from out of state, everyone in both households must quarantine for 14 days, or 7 days with a negative test.
- The Health Department strongly advises against non-essential travel, even within Vermont. All travel to and from Vermont requires quarantine. The only exception is [essential travel](#).

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We would like to remind you if you choose to not follow state guidelines regarding social gatherings, travel or self-select quarantine for any reason, your child will be marked absent as they will not physically present for in person learning. Maintenance of learning school work can be provided to the students in these situations. In order to return to school following quarantine, you should plan for your child to have a COVID-19 PCR test after 7 days and report negative results to the school before returning or quarantine for 14 days.
