Article 253 – RtI Consultant - -Gifted and Talented

RtI Consultant – Gifted and Talented will report to the Director of Instruction and/or the District Administrator. This position is outside the duties of the regular teaching contract; RtI Consultant – Gifted and Talented is expected to work approximately 110 extra hours during the school year calendar. Consultation will take place before or after school. Proposed Compensation: \$2200.00.

Qualifications:

1. WI Teaching License, Gifted and Talented certification preferred
2. Knowledge of Differentiated Instruction.
3. Knowledge of student assessment practices.
4. Excellent communication skills.

Responsibilities:

1. Consult with classroom teachers to develop different programming to meet Tier 2 and Tier 3 needs.
2. Communicate scheduling changes to building principal(s).
3. Orientate parents and teachers to available Gifted and Talented services in classroom.
4. Communicate with G/T Events Coordinator regarding student needs.
5. Supervise the development and maintenance of Educational Acceleration Plan (EAP).
6. Monitor the implementation of student EAP. Ensure that EAP is recorded in Skyward Student Information System.
7. Coordinate the successful transition between grade levels of students in the G/T program.
8. Educate parents about the District's G/T service model.
9. Provide research-based classroom enrichment/acceleration models, materials and resources focused on inclusion and the integration of differentiated instruction.
10. Fulfill expectations of statute and board policy.
11. Other duties as assigned by the Director of Instruction or the District Administrator.
