Article 427 – High School Classes Taught at the Middle School

Beginning in the 2015-16 SY, students in grades seven and eight may take high school credit while in middle school as long as the teacher of the course has the appropriate secondary teaching license. Students will earn credit and the grade at the Middle School. Upon transferring to the High School, the course(s) will appear on the high school transcript with the grade but will not count towards the 48 required courses for graduation. Grades earned in 7th or 8th grade will not be included in the calculation of a student's high school GPA and they will not be used in the determination of class rank for scholarship purposes.
