Do's and Don'ts of the Walkers Program

Do

- Enter and Exit only through door E
- Wear your walkers ID at all times
- Be responsible for your own safety within the building, be aware of your surroundings
- Stay in the 100 & 200 hallways

Do Not

- Give your badge to someone else
- Go to other areas outside of the 100 & 200 hallways without first leaving the building.
- Go into any classrooms
