Registration: 5:00-6:30 p.m.
No appointment needed; patients are seen on a first come, first served basis

Who:

Adult residents of Monroe County 18 years of age and older with no public or private medical insurance. Financial eligibility is reviewed at registration and is based on income and family size.

What:

- Basic health care treatment for acute and chronic medical problems
- In-house pharmacy for prescribed medications (no narcotics are prescribed)
- Referrals to Mayo Clinic Health System or Gundersen Health System specialists if recommended by volunteer providers
- No services available for mental health counseling, dental care, or vision care
