



MEASURE M CITIZENS' OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

**Application for Appointment**

Background: On November 3, 2020, the Goleta Union School District passed Measure M, an \$80 million bond measure. The District Board of Trustees took action to approve Resolution No. 2021-06 on April 14, 2021 establishing the Citizens' Oversight Committee (COC) so the District now seeks interested community members to become part of its COC. The purpose of the COC is to keep the public informed of the District's expenditure of bond revenues and to report on the expenditure of taxpayer funds to ensure they are spent only for permissible purposes. COC members do not select and or prioritize projects to be funded by Measure M proceeds. Details on the role of COC members is in Resolution 2021-06.

Each member will serve a two-year term, and the District anticipates that the COC will meet from 4-6 times per year. The COC is subject to the Ralph M. Brown (Open Meetings) Act.

Instructions: Interested applicants must complete this form and submit it to the office of the Goleta Union School District Assistant Superintendent, Fiscal Services, by **June 4, 2021, at 5pm**. Applicants may be contacted for further follow-up or interview. The District anticipates appointment of members at its June 9, 2021 meeting. Applicants may apply for an "At-Large" position or may apply to meet one of the categories described below. The District anticipates appointing 7 individuals to its COC.
