Parents of students in Kindergarten are encouraged to leave a Ziploc bag labeled with the child's name with a spare change of clothes in the classroom throughout the year for emergencies. **PLAIN with no writing, Navy Blue Jackets, sweaters or sweatshirts and school authorized zippered sweatshirts without hoodies are the only outwear permitted at Leadership Preparatory Academy.** Absolutely no jeans will be allowed on any day (no matter the temperature) unless the student chooses to participate with Dress-Down Days.

Beginning Monday, February 4, 2019, students who do not dress in uniform, will be placed in detention and parents will be contacted. Please assist us in helping our students abide by the rules and regulations of our school.
