To recap, next year during construction of our Upper School we will operate on four campuses:

- K-2 will remain at Celadon
- Grades 3-5 will be at the Main Campus on Boundary
- Grades 6-7 will be at Greene Street
- Our Upper School, Grades, 8-11 next year, will be in temporary modular cottages at our school site in Port Royal, on SC170 across from the water tower.

Construction of the permanent school will be ongoing at the new site, but we will make sure the work and workers are separated from the Upper School students. Part of our construction planning is to provide security for our students and staff at the Upper School during construction. Fencing, controlled entries and security cameras are part of the plans we will be reviewing for all campuses.
