Deborah Hamner's Musicians of the Month for February!

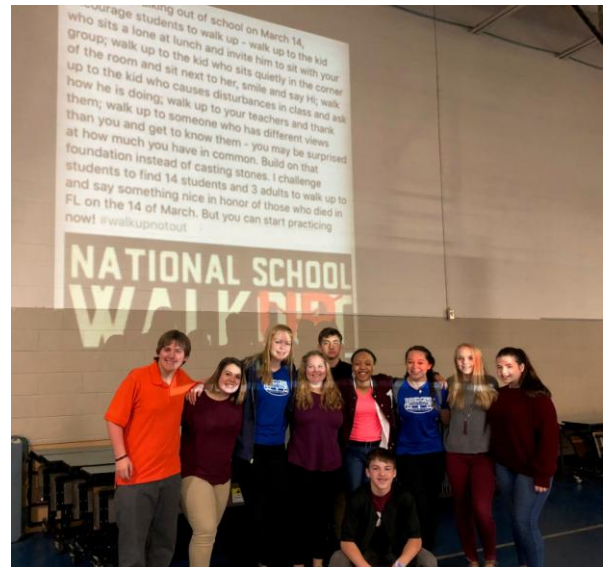
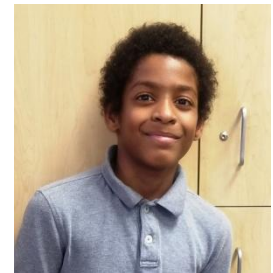
