

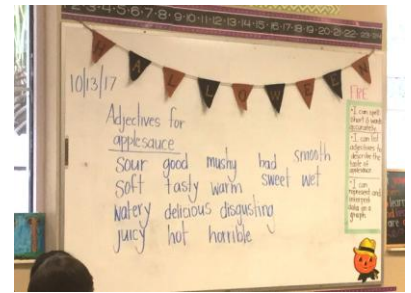
Bridges Prep News & Notes: Nov. 3, 2017
