The following rules apply for all students and their guests attending the prom:

- ◆ Guest must be between the ages of 15 and 20.
- ◆ Guest must be currently enrolled in a regular high school program, be a high school graduate OR have earned a G.E.D. (students will not be permitted if they are enrolled in alternative school, have been expelled/recommended for expulsion, or have any serious prior or current discipline record)
- ◆ Non-Bridges Preparatory School students may be subject to prior approval before attending the prom.
- ◆ The student and guest must wear appropriate prom attire. Refer to the bottom of this page for the prom dress code and sign stating that you have read and agree to abide by the dress code.
- ◆ Non-Bridges guests must provide identification (school ID or driver's license) in order to enter the prom.
- ◆ No refunds will be given.

I, (BPS student) _____, understand that I will be held responsible for not only my behavior but, the behavior of my guest while at the prom. Also, I realize that my parent(s)/guardian(s) and guest's parent(s)/guardian(s) must sign this form signifying their awareness of my date and the rules including dress code and appropriate dancing, set forth by my school and Bridges Preparatory School. Furthermore, I realize that alcohol, drugs and tobacco products are prohibited at Bridges Preparatory School functions and that all disciplinary rules are in effect.

PROM DRESS CODE

The Prom, an important part of the Bridges Preparatory School, is a formal social event; therefore everyone attending the prom, including guests, is expected to dress and behave appropriately for a formal event.

- Young men are expected to wear formal evening attire that would include a tuxedo, suit with a tie, or sport coat with slacks and a tie. *No flip-flops or athletic shoes.* Jackets and vests may be removed, but shirts may not be removed.
- Young women are expected to wear formal evening attire. Dresses may not expose a bare midriff. Mesh or see-through inserts in the midriff area will not be allowed. Two-piece dresses/outfits must not expose any midriff. Front, back, and sides of ladies' attire must not be too low-cut or revealing.
- Short dresses or side slits may not be higher than the tips of the wearer's fingers when the wearer's hands are at her sides. Ladies may not hike up their dresses in order to dance.

If not appropriately dressed, you will not be allowed to enter the prom. If you have any questions, contact Mr. Kabel at BPS. **Remember, if in doubt, don't wear it!**

Students and guests may be asked to leave if attire or behavior becomes inappropriate or conflicts with school rules. Faculty members will make the final decision regarding appropriate attire and behavior.
