Statewide Assessment Highlights

- Five-year upward trends across SC READY and EOC.
- Reading growth increases driven by LETRS, CKLA, and strengthened K–3 literacy systems.
- Math growth averaged at 62% schoolwide with gains in K-3 and targeted MTSS support.

ELA Performance Highlights

- 3rd Grade: Proficiency increased from 41% → 73% and held at 68% in 2024–25.
- 4th Grade: Proficiency increased from 44% → 80%.
- 7th Grade: Achieved 74% proficiency, the highest on record.
- High School English 2 EOC: Over 90% pass rate, including 12 perfect scores.

Math Growth & Acceleration

- 3rd Grade: 36% → 58% proficiency; STAR growth peaked at 75%.
- 4th Grade: Rebounded to 72% proficiency after pandemic declines.
- Middle School: Growth supported by PLC alignment, standards-based instruction, and WIN/ET interventions.
- High School: SREB Math strengthened readiness for Algebra 1; improved “C or better” outcomes.

Science & Social Studies

- Biology: 54.5% scoring C or better; recovery supports in place for 2025–26.
- U.S. History: 57.3% scoring C or better—above state performance—with gains tied to DOK-aligned instruction.

Achievement Gaps Narrowing

- Students with Disabilities: 16% → 28% proficiency.
- Pupils in Poverty: 56% → 62% proficiency.
- Growth Strong: SGP above 50 across grades 3–5 in Reading and Math.
- Improvements linked to MTSS, targeted interventions, STAR CBM, and strengthened Tier 1 instruction.



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Progress Toward 2034 Academic Goals

STEM & Academic Programming

- 100% K–8 PLTW access through Launch and Gateway courses.
- 100% pass rate on PLTW EOCs (Computer Science, Biomedical Science, Human Body Systems).
- First Governor’s Seal recipients expected in 2026; meeting Year 2–3 targets.

Climate & Whole-Child Support

- Report Card Climate Survey results:
 - Elementary: 7.15/10 (Average)
 - Middle: 6.5/10 (Average)
 - High: 3.47/5 (Good)
- Continued initiatives include Responsive Classroom, Paideia Seminars, student/teacher incentives, counseling checkpoints, internal surveys, and IGP development.

Facilities & Infrastructure

- Phase 4 construction begins February 2026, adding:
 - New Grades 3–6 school
 - CATE wing
 - Community cafeteria
- Scheduled completion: August 2027, supporting 2,500 students

Talent Acquisition & Retention

- 98% certified staff, exceeding Year 10 target of 95%.
- Success supported by mentorships, recruiting fairs, PD cycles, vertical alignment, and culture-building events.

Community Partnerships & Engagement

- 226 SLED-cleared volunteers and 2,186 visitors to the school in 2024–25.
- 26 business partnerships, increased from 21.
- Active involvement in civic organizations and community events, including American Legion, Adopt-a-Highway and Beaufort Water Festival.
