<input type="checkbox"/> Open Portal- Within 3-4 business days after applying you should receive college ID with instructions on how to activate your portal. The portal is the main way in which colleges communicate so be checking this constantly.
<input type="checkbox"/> Assessment- Every college has a different process to help students identify best fit classes. Be sure to complete assessment to know what classes can be more helpful to you!
<input type="checkbox"/> Accommodations- If you had a 504 plan or IEP while in high school or believe you may need accommodations contact the office of Disability Services Program to receive the intake documentation and schedule a meeting with a counselor.
