ELECTRONICS TECHNICIAN III

Required Qualifications:

- High school diploma or General Education Diploma (GED)
- Must have seven (7) years of work experience supplemented by approved training in area of specialization and promotion review
- Valid Florida driver's license
- Knowledge of hand tools and test equipment such as ammeters, volt/ohm meters, oscilloscopes and signal generators
- Carry out written and oral instructions and communicate effectively
- Be able to distinguish colors
- Be able to lift heavy loads
- Ability to work from ladders, high lifts, etc.
- Ability to work with polyvinyl chloride pipe and electrical metallic tubing

Performance Responsibilities:

- Install, maintain and repair clock systems, intercom systems, fire alarm systems, public address systems, CATV systems, audio visual equipment, scoreboards, desktop and laptop computer (Windows and Macintosh based), low voltage wiring and cabling
- Review and recommend specifications for new and replacement electronic systems
- Provide technical support to end users
- Provide preventive maintenance using test equipment, blueprints, schematics, service manuals and any other means to maintain existing electronic systems
- Installation of new equipment
- Perform system tests and programming as needed
- Maintain an inventory of parts and materials as needed
- Research and order parts as needed
- Maintain appropriate records
- Coordinate work to be completed within house capabilities and outside agencies
- Schedule responsibilities to maintain necessary equipment
- Work in confined spaces
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Director of Maintenance and/or designee
