# **Required Qualifications:**

#### **Performance Responsibilities:**

- Assist in the design, implementation and evaluation of interventions for students experiencing learning and behavioral difficulties through active involvement in the Student Support Team and consultation with teachers
- Administer and interpret psychological and direct assessment instruments for evaluation of students with learning and/or adjustment problems
- Administer and interpret psychological assessment instruments as required for reevaluation of students in Exceptional Student Education programs
- Provide a written psychological and/or consultation report which includes evaluation results
- Provide feedback regarding the evaluation to the child, parent and school personnel as appropriate
- Provide inservice training to school personnel and parents on psychological, educational and developmental issues
- Assist school teams with Functional Behavioral Assessments
- Assist in planning, implementation and evaluation of school and district-wide programs that address problems, as well as assist with school reform efforts
- Counsel individual students and groups of students to enhance their self-efficacy and adjustment
- Assist in developing crisis intervention plans and provide services in reaction to crisis
