Required Qualifications:

- Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) Instructor with Military Service Instructor Certification
- Available to devote necessary time (this is a yearlong activity to include weekends, school breaks and holidays) and effort for practice; supporting school and community events; and participating in State and National Competitions

Performance Responsibilities:

- Be responsible for the development and operation of Color Guard and Saber Guard Teams to follow guidelines of the School District and the particular U.S. Armed Forces (Air Force, Army, Marines, Navy)
- Be responsible for the official activities that team members will be involved with both during and after school hours
- Select and train members for the teams from JROTC Cadets
- Plan, schedule, supervise and chaperone teams members as they practice, perform at school or community events (which include but not limited to: athletic events; parades; graduation; special assemblies; etc) and at State and National Competitions
- Supervise fundraising and all financial aspects of the program
- Establish guidelines for conduct and participation at school and community events
- Encourage academic success
- Be responsible for all uniforms and equipment
- Perform other duties as assigned the principal and/or designee

Physical Demands:

Exerting up to 100 pounds of force occasionally and/or up to 50 pounds of force frequently, and/or up to 20 pounds of force regularly or as needed to move objects
