Required Qualifications:

- Minimum of high school diploma or equivalent

Desired Qualifications:

- Florida Educator's Certification in Music (K-12)
- Experience in vocal productions

Performance Responsibilities:

- Supervise all choral activities: performances, field trips, before/after school rehearsals and District and State festivals
- Develop fundamentals of vocal productions, sight reading and musicianship
- Present programs (minimum of 2 per year) for parents and interested community groups
- Supervise students during the total program times (including staying after said performances until last student has been released to parent/guardian)
- Contact parents about affairs of the chorus via phone or written communication
- See that all necessary props, supplies and music are at the site performances
- Secure outside volunteer assistance, as needed
- Promote public relations
- Assist in student development of interpersonal skills, confidence, self-discipline, and pride in achievement
- Perform other duties as assigned by the principal and/or designee

Physical Demands:

Exerting up to 50 pounds of force occasionally and/or up to 20 pounds of force frequently, and/or up to 10 pounds of force regularly or as needed to move objects
