Desired Qualifications:

- Be able to establish rapport with students

- Be able to apply appropriate knowledge and skills for the implementation of a continuous developmental program

Performance Responsibilities:

- Teach intellectually disabled students
- Study and be able to use assessment information
- Conduct diagnostic testing
- Develop and implement Individual Educational Programs (IEPs)
- Establish positive relationships with parents
- Work with government agencies to obtain appropriate assistance for students
- Ascertain that all required confidential information is in students' folders
- Reevaluate and conduct continuation staffings at least annually
- Implement a diagnostic, individualized program for each student
- Take advantage of inservice training
- Attend departmental meetings
- Order well in advance materials and equipment to expand and improve the program
- Submit an annual program evaluation, according to district procedures, to the principal and the Director of Exceptional Student Education
- Perform other duties as assigned by the principal and/or designee

Physical Demands:

Exerting up to 50 pounds of force occasionally and/or up to 20 pounds of force frequently, and/or up to 10 pounds of force regularly or as needed to move objects
