Required Qualifications:

- Bachelor’s Degree
- Florida certification in Exceptional Student Education

Desired Qualifications:

- Be knowledgeable of the continuum of services available for exceptional students
- Be able to establish rapport with students
- Be able to establish positive relationships with parents and fellow workers
- Be able to apply appropriate knowledge and skills for the implementation of a continuous developmental program

Performance Responsibilities:

- Teach students with disabilities to include but not limited to learning disabilities, physically handicapped, emotionally behaviorally disturbed and intellectual disabilities
- Study and be able to use assessment information
- Develop and implement Individual Educational Plans (IEPs) based upon diagnostic data
- Serve as a resource to general education teachers and provide assistance to them in remediating children with disabilities
- Teach and remediate students based upon their needs
- Keep records of children’s progress and report progress at regular designated intervals
- Attend inservice training to improve skills and knowledge
- Attend departmental meetings
- Order well in advance materials and equipment to expand and improve the program
- Submit an annual program evaluation, according to district procedures, to the principal and the Director of Exceptional Student Education
- Perform other duties as assigned by the principal and/or designee

Physical Demands:

Exerting up to 100 pounds of force occasionally and/or up to 50 pounds of force frequently, and/or up to 20 pounds of force regularly or as needed to move objects
