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Springstead High School IB Programme prerequisites:

In order to be considered for the IB Programme at SHS, potential IB students need to meet the following criteria:

1. ELA and Math **FSA scores of 3 or higher**.
2. Completion of **Algebra 1*** before entering the 9th grade.
3. For students pursuing Spanish as their foreign language track, **Spanish 1*** must be complete before entering the 9th grade.
4. Student should be in **good academic and/or behavioral standing** with their current middle school.
5. Students should be **motivated** to not only achieve in the classroom, but also seek **involvement** in various extra-curricular activities.

*Students may complete these courses through Hernando eSchool or FLVS. In such cases, the course **MUST** be complete by the first day of school.

IB Student Applicant & Parent Acknowledgment:

1. Students must meet with the IB Coordinator for an interview in order to be considered for the IB Programme at SHS. The student interview does not guarantee placement in the IB Programme, and space in the program **WILL** be limited. Furthermore, we understand that meeting Springstead High School's eligibility requirements for the IB Programme **DOES NOT** ensure admission to the program as well.
2. The decision of the IB Coordinator is final. Students who are not accepted into the program will have the option of being wait listed for potential openings.
3. Students who need to take Algebra 1 and/or Spanish 1 online to meet Springstead High School's IB Programme prerequisites understand that the course(s) must be completed by the first day of school. Failure to do so may jeopardize student placement in the IB Programme. Students attending on school choice may be removed, and will need to return to their zoned high school. The IB Coordinator reserves sole discretion to make such decisions.
4. Out of zone students who are admitted to the SHS IB Programme, and receive school choice to attend, understand that if they choose to leave the program, or if removed by the IB Coordinator, they will lose their school choice and must return to their zoned high school at a date determined by the IB Coordinator.
5. If admitted, students are expected to maintain a 2.0 unweighted GPA in their classes at all times. Students are expected to attend tutoring to receive additional support. Students who fall below the 2.0 GPA requirement in 1 or more classes may be placed on academic probation and risk placement in the program.
6. If admitted, students are expected to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner at all times. Inappropriate conduct will not be tolerated. Students who choose to engage in such behavior may be withdrawn from the IB Programme at SHS at any point by the IB Coordinator. Students attending on school choice will forfeit this privilege and will return to their zoned school at a date determined by the IB Coordinator.
7. If admitted, students will be required to participate in 1 extracurricular school based activity or club per year. The IB Coordinator will make every attempt to encourage and identify potential activities for students. Students who choose to not seek involvement risk their placement in the IB Programme.
8. There are no fees associated with student participation in the IB Programme during the pre-IB years (9th and 10th grades).
