

COVID 19 Protocols

Updated for 2021-2022

Hernando School District has updated health and wellness protocols in accordance with Governor's Executive Order and recommendations from the Department of Health.

Face Coverings

- NEW Strongly recommended but <u>optional</u> for students, staff and visitors.
- A limited supply of disposable masks will be available.

Quarantine

 NEW - Vaccinated students or staff, who are sympton-free but who have been identified as being in close contact with a Covid positive individual, will NOT be quarantined.

*Digital Home Learning - Per Governor's Executive Order, a digital home learning option for 2021-22 is not permitted.

Notification

- When an individual is confirmed positive for COVID-19, a decision is made in consultation with the Department of Health (DOH), to determine who should quarantine and for how long.
- Due to privacy laws, the district cannot share test result information. Notice of a confirmed positive will be shared with families of students who are determined to be in close contact with the positive individual.
- The school will provide general notification of a confirmed positive case.
- In the event of a substantial spread, the district may be directed to close a classroom, hallway or individual school.

School Spaces

<u>Classrooms</u>

- Adhere to social distancing where possible.
- Limit sharing of classroom materials.
- For classrooms with sinks routine hand washing will be practiced.
- Hand sanitizing stations are available in hallways & common areas.
- Frequent sanitization of contact areas/touchpoints will occur.
- Student movement may be organized and monitored for safety.

Cafeteria

- Adhere to social distancing where possible.
- Hand sanitizer stations located at the entryway in the cafeteria.
- Pin pads will only be used for all a carte items and will be sanitized after each use.

Clinic

- Clinic staff will wear personal protective equipment.
- A separate clinic space will be utilized to separate symptomatic individuals from standard clinic operations.
- Each clinic uses an air purification unit. This clean air technology filters air by trapping and removing contaminants.
- Sanitization will occur after each student visit.

Cleaning

- School buses and classrooms are disinfected daily.
- Restrooms will be disinfected throughout the day.
- Enhanced cleaning and disinfecting of classrooms and all areas will take place each night.
- Electrostatic sprayers will be used to disinfect classrooms, busses, and common spaces.
- Additional custodial support at schools to ensure routine and frequent cleaning of high traffic areas and touchpoints.
- Signage with reminders to wash hands, use hand sanitizer and practice social distancing will be displayed.

Key Reminders

- Encourage children to wash their hands frequently and to use hand sanitizers located on all buses, stationed throughout the school including classrooms and cafeterias.
- DO NOT send children to the bus stop or to school if they have symptoms or feel sick.
