## District announces Principal and Assistant Principal of the year for 2023

Brooksville – Hernando Schools Superintendent John Stratton, School Board members and district leaders made two surprise visits to announce the 2023 leaders of the year for the school district. Their first stop was to Challenger K-8, where they announced Principal Rosemarie Maiorini as the 2023 Principal of the Year; then to Powell Middle School to announce Alex Rastatter as the 2023 Assistant Principal of the Year. Both Maiorini and Rastatter were quite surprised as they were greeted with flowers, balloons and a gathering of family, coworkers and friends.

Maiorini, who is a graduate of Central High School, began her career with the district in 1995 as an elementary teacher at JD Floyd. In 2015, she was selected as assistant principal of Challenger K8 before taking over as the school's principal in 2018. "I am overwhelmed," Maiorini said. "I'm so appreciative and thankful.
