

College Application Vocabulary

- Early Action: non-binding. You will receive acceptance notification earlier than regular admissions and can apply to many schools.
- Early Decision: binding. You may only apply ED to one school. This means if you are accepted through early decision, you are committed to attending that school and must withdraw other applications.

- Regular Decision: non-binding. Your application will be reviewed after a hard deadline with all other applicants.
- Rolling Decision: non-binding. Applications are reviewed as they come in.





*Freshman merit scholarships are competitive and not guaranteed. Preference is given to students who apply by the early action date of November 1st.

Note: Applications received after these deadlines will be processed on a space-available basis.

Deposit Note: The admissions deposit is applicable to the term for which the student has been admitted and is non-refundable. The deposit will be forfeited if the student does not enroll in the deposited term. If a request to change terms is made after classes for the original term of admission have begun, a deposit for the new term must be paid. The deposit deadline for fall is May 1st, however, we may accept deposits after the deadline until the term is full.

Awards are distributed over 4 years and range from: \$1,000 to \$12,000 for Florida residents (deadline November 1, 2024) Applicants must have their scores sent directly to FIU when they register for tests so the scores can be received by the university in time for admission for scholarship consideration. Recommended last test dates for scholarship consideration are: ACT September 14, 2024 CLT September 21, 2024 SAT October 5, 2024

The Florida State University's Vires Scholarship is a total amount of \$16,000*, which will be distributed throughout eight semesters in \$2,000 increments at the beginning of each fall and spring term.
 - Applicants are automatically considered for the Mores Scholarship. A separate application is not required. The Florida State
 University's total value of the award is \$12,000, which will be distributed throughout eight semesters in \$1,500 increments at
 the beginning of each fall and spring term.
 - IB Diploma Scholarship recognizes students who have demonstrated exceptional academic performance by completing the rigorous and internationally recognized International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Program. The Florida State University's total value of the award is \$8,000, which will be distributed throughout eight semesters in \$1,000 increments at the beginning of each fall and spring term.

The Scholarship Committee reviews admitted FTIC students until all scholarship funding has been allocated and is usually exhausted by mid-January for the incoming summer and fall classes.

AUGUST 1



Students can apply for freshman admission using the institution application or the Common App.

NOVEMBER 1

Priority Application Deadline

Students must submit their application to USF by the priority deadline to qualify for benefits like:

- Priority decision notification on December 10
- · Priority consideration for term and campus of choice

Students who do not apply by the priority deadline will be considered for their campus of choice on a space-available basis.

NOVEMBER 15

Priority Supporting Documents Deadline

Students must submit all required documents (including SSAR, application fee and test scores) to qualify for priority admission benefits.

DECEMBER 10

Priority Decision Release Day

Students who applied and submitted all required documents by the priority deadlines will receive their admissions decision on December 10. Admissions decisions will roll out for non-priority applicants starting on December 16.

JANUARY 15

Application Deadline for Scholarship Consideration

Students must submit a general USF application and supporting documents by January 15 to be automatically considered for merit-based admissions scholarships.

MARCH 1

Final Application Deadline

Students must apply by March 1 to be considered for freshman admission to USF.

MARCH 15

Final Supporting Documents Deadline

Students must submit all required documents (application fee, test scores and SSAR/ transcripts) to USF by March 15 to be considered for freshman admission.

MAY 1

Confirm Enrollment (Deposit Deadline)

Students who plan to attend USF must pay their nonrefundable \$200 admissions deposit by May 1. Please note: the earlier a student submits their deposit, the sooner they can qualify for in-demand on-campus housing, reserve an Orientation date and more.
