- Fox Chapel Middle School will increase proficiency levels to: ELA 40%, Math 42%, and Science 38% - as comparable to Pre-COVID proficiency levels.
- Fox Chapel Middle School will improve discipline records so that 80% of students receive 1 or less office discipline referral.
- Fox Chapel Middle School will increase attendance rates so that 80% of students will obtain above 90% daily attendance.
