**Special Dress Days**

The following shirts can be worn...

- Spirit Fridays-ONLY 24-25 Spirit shirts or shirts earned through a Moton program, such as Star Readers, etc.
- Theme "Kindness" Mondays - shirts that have sayings about kindness, words from our PRIDE acronym or school-wide theme
- Occasionally, there is no school on Monday or Friday due to holidays or professional days, so there will be no Theme or Spirit day that week.  
Uniforms must then be worn.

**Hats, Hair & Piercings**

\***NO** hats, sunglasses, bandanas, durags or beanies are to be worn of any kind except during a special event or circumstance approved by admin.

\***NO** facial piercings or "faux" facial gems.

**CONSEQUENCES**

\*MES Loaners are an option only if they are available

**1<sup>ST</sup> Offense:**

- Parent called to bring appropriate clothes or student will wear \*MES loaner

**2<sup>nd</sup> Offense:**

- Parent called to bring appropriate clothes or student will wear \*MES loaner
- 1 day Lunch Detention (*minimum*)

**3<sup>rd</sup> Offense:**

- Parent called to bring appropriate clothes
- 3 days Lunch Detention (*minimum*)
- Guidance Referral

**4<sup>th</sup> Offense:**

- Parent called to bring appropriate clothes
- Discipline Referral
- 1 day ISS (*minimum*)
- Required Parent Conference

**5<sup>th</sup> Offense:**

- Parent called to bring appropriate clothes
- Discipline Referral
- 2 to 3 days ISS
- Required Parent Conference

*\*\*After the 1<sup>st</sup> nine weeks, students with previous dress code violations will automatically be sent to ISS for the remainder of the day.*

*\*\*Additional consequences may be added based on the number of offenses.*

## Dress for Success: MES Dress Code

- Clothing is to support the academic atmosphere of a school classroom & must not be disruptive or distracting to the learning environment.
- All clothing, except school-sponsored items cannot have graphics or writing larger than 1-2 inches.
- All clothing is to be without rips or holes that show skin and appropriately fitted.
- Undergarments are **NOT** to be visible.

### Jeans

- Uniform, as described in the "Appropriate Bottoms" section
- Plain jeans/shorts (no shorter than fingertips)
- Jeans/shorts can also be in uniform colors navy (dark blue), black, gray or khaki.
- Jeans/shorts may have small embroidered designs.
- NO "distressed jeans" with scrapes, frays or patches even if skin is not showing.
- NO holes, rips or tears that show skin
- NO hip-huggers or low-rise sagging that show undergarments.
- NO other colors, logos, designs, prints, leopard prints, flowers, patterns, stripes, crisscross suede laces, tie-dyed, etc.

### Appropriate Shoes

- \*All shoes must be closed-toed.  
ex. tennis shoes, ballet flats, boots.



### NON PERMISSIBLE SHOES

\*For Safety from slipping/falling

- NO heels
- NO backless or platform shoes
- NO board (wheeled) shoes
- NO slippers or flip flop style shoes
- NO Crocs of any kind

## Appropriate Tops

- Solid color cotton/polyester blend, "polo"/golf-style (2-3 buttons at the top) and "oxford" style (button all the way down) properly fitted shirts with sleeves (long or short)
- Pattern/Print long sleeved shirts can be worn under a uniform appropriate top.
- Solid color sweaters or sweatshirts may be worn with a uniform top underneath.

\*\* Sweaters and sweatshirts may **NOT** be worn to hide dress code violations (shirt collar should be visible at the neck area).

\*\* Shirts must be long enough to cover the midriff area when both arms are raised.



### NON-PERMISSIBLE TOPS

- NO plaid, stripes, flowers, designs, prints, duo colors or sleeveless shirts.
- NO tight fitting/see-through shirts.
- NO logos or emblems larger than 1-2 inches.
- NO capped sleeves, sleeveless, spaghetti straps, spandex, or stretch material of any kind.
- NO zippers or lace on shirts.
- NO bare midriffs.



### Jackets

- Jackets **MUST** have a front zipper or buttons/snaps that go from top to bottom

~They can have hoods. Hoods can not be worn inside buildings and classrooms.

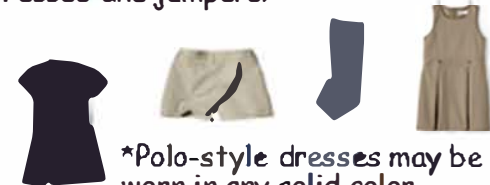
• NO Hoodies \*A "hoodie" is one that has to be pulled over the head to put on because it does not have a full zipper or buttons/snaps. This includes "hoodies" with and without pockets.

**Note:** Jackets do NOT have to be a solid color. All patterns must be appropriate patterns & logos.

\*Jackets may **NOT** be worn to hide dress code violations.

## Appropriate Bottoms

- "Uniform style" pants, capris, shorts, skorts, skirts, jumpers in black, gray, navy (dark blue) or khaki solid color **ONLY** and must be the appropriate size for the student. (shorts, skorts, skirts and jumpers can be NO shorter than fingertips)
- Pants do not have to be "uniform" brand, but **MUST** be fitted at the waist. (Outside pockets are allowed)
- Pants should be regular fit style with a boot cut, slightly flared or the new style with elastic bands at the bottom of the pant leg made of cotton/polyester or cotton blends.
- Pattern/Print leggings can be worn under uniform shorts, skorts, skirts, dresses and jumpers.



\*Polo-style dresses may be worn in any solid color.

- \*Shorts should be worn under skirts and dresses.

### NON PERMISSIBLE BOTTOMS

- NO stripes, flowers, designs, prints, logos, duo-colors, etc.
- NO sweatpants, athletic pants, joggers, pajama bottoms, corduroys, stretch pants, spandex, leggings, jeggings, etc. (Pattern/Print leggings can be worn under uniform bottoms—see above for details)
- NO slits in pants, skirts, skorts or jumpers will open more than 2 inches from the bottom.
- NO pants that are long enough to pile up on shoes or drag the floor.
- NO short-shorts (no shorter than fingertips)
