Required Qualifications:

- Minimum of high school diploma or equivalent
- Florida Educator's Certificate*
- First aid training, injury prevention
- Hold and maintain a certification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation, first aid (CPR), and the use of an automatic external defibrillator. The certification must be consistent with national evidence-based emergency cardiovascular care guidelines.
- Willingness to devote time before and after school

Desired Qualifications:

- Knowledge of sports theory and application
- Knowledge of physical training and/or basic kinesiology
- Trained in teaching necessary techniques and skills

Performance Responsibilities:

- Provide leadership, teach competitiveness and sportsmanship for sport assigned
- Plan and supervise a conditioning program according to sport
- Select team participants
- Plan/supervise all practices, games/meets and tournaments
- Issue uniforms and/or equipment and maintain inventory
- Create game plan strategies, goal setting, and positive attitude
- Encourage academic, as well as athletic, achievement
- Assist Athletic Director with schedules, budgets, contracts and busing
- Serve as a liaison to parents, boosters and media
- Perform other duties as assigned by the principal and/or designee

Physical Demands:

Exerting up to 100 pounds of force occasionally and/or up to 50 pounds of force frequently, and/or up to 20 pounds of force regularly or as needed to move objects
