Begin your career in an entry level position and take advantage of:

## **Entry level positions**

## **Patient Transporter**

- High school diploma or GED required.
- Strong interpersonal and customer service skills required.
- · Able to work in a fast-paced environment.
- · enrolled in healthcare courses preferred
- Ability to perform work that requires frequent standing, bending, reaching, squatting, kneeling, moving, lifting of patients and/or equipment up to 50 lbs.
- · Current BLS through the American Heart Association is required.

#### **Monitor Tech**

- · High School Graduate or equivalent.
- BLS Healthcare Provider.
- Completion of Basic EKG/Arrhythmia course. Demonstrated ability to interpret cardiac rhythms and arrhythmias.
- Working knowledge of medical terminology.
- CMT/Cardiac Experience Preferred.
- · Customer service abilities including effective listening skills.
- · Ability to remain focused and maintain concentration over extended period of time.
- · Ability to quickly make decisions to report patient condition with minimal supervision.

#### Patient Care Tech

- Current BLS Certification from the American Red Cross (HCA chosen provider) OR American Heart Association is required
- CNA not required
- HCA Healthcare will train you through the StarTECH Cohort program

#### Food and Nutrition Services Assistant

High school diploma or GED preferred

#### **Environmental Services Assistant**

High school diploma or GED preferred.

## **Patient Safety Attendant**

Current BLS (Basic Life Support) required on all clinical nursing units. De-escalation training Required completion within 90 days of position start date. CPI (Crisis Prevention
Intervention) training may be required based on assignment.

#### Nursing

- Job outlook: 9% increase from 2020 to 2030
- Salary range: \$53,410-\$116,230 (\$25.68-\$55.88 per hour)\*
- Education requirement: Associate degree
- How long is the program? About two years
- Complete the state exam and obtain state licensure

## Occupational Therapy Assistants (OTA)

- Job outlook: 36% increase from 2020-2030
- Average salary: \$57,330-\$122,670 (\$27.56-\$58.98 per hour)
- · Education requirement: Associate degree
- Two-year program
- Obtain an associate degree from an accredited occupational therapy program
- Pass the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy (NBCOT) exam to become a certified OTA

#### **Pharmacists**

- Pay range: \$76,840-\$164,590 (\$36.94-\$79.13 per hour)\*
- Complete Pharmacy Technician Certification (as soon as 9 months)
- Complete the Pharmacy Technician Certification Examination® (PTCE®) or the Exam for the Certification of Pharmacy Technicians (ExCPT).

## **Pharmacy Tech**

- Pay range: \$33,206-\$41,087\* (\$15.96-\$19.75 per hour)\*
- Complete Pharmacy Technician Certification (as soon as 9 months)
- Complete the Pharmacy Technician Certification Examination® (PTCE®) or the Exam for the Certification of Pharmacy Technicians (ExCPT).

#### **Phlebotomist**

- Pay range: \$31,282 and \$38,786 (\$15.04-\$18.65 per hour)\*
- Attend a Florida State Accredited Phlebotomy Training program

#### Physical Therapist Assistant (PTA)

- Job outlook: 35% increase from 2020-2030
- Average salary: \$20,500-\$40,580 (\$9.86-\$19.51 per hour)\*
- Education requirement: Associate degree
- How long is the program? Less than two years (typically 20 months)

### Radiology Technologists

- Average salary: \$52,880-\$104,210 (\$25.42-\$50.10 per hour)\*
- Earn a diploma, certificate, or degree in radiography, radiation therapy, or other modality.
- · Pass the ARRT or JRCNMT exam.
- · Apply for your license.
- Pursue ARRT certification, if desired. Certification by the ARRT is a separate process from the licensure exam, which can add to your professional credentials.
- · Complete continuing education.

## **Respiratory Therapist**

- Pay range: \$45,940-\$89,170 (\$22.09-\$42.87 per hour)\*
- · Complete an approved Respiratory Therapist degree program
- Take the Certified Respiratory Therapist (CRT) Examination
- · Complete required training: Prevention of Medical Errors
- · Apply for a Florida license
