What is a School Advisory Council?

The School Advisory Council (SAC) is a team representing various community segments: parents, teachers, students, administrators, support staff, business/industry people, and other interested community members. The purpose of a SAC is to assist in the preparation and evaluation (developing and evaluating) of the results of the school improvement plan and to assist the principal with the annual school budget. Additionally, SAC receives funds "to be used at the discretion of the School Advisory Committee. A portion of the money should be used for implementing the school improvement plan." "The improvement plan shall include performance indicators which are measurable." "Funding for use by the School Advisory Council should be allocated directly to the School Advisory Councils, should be clearly earmarked for their use, and is not subject to override by the Principal or interim approvals by school district staff. This money may be expended only on programs or projects the school advisory council selects. This money may not be used for capital improvements."
