

Welcome to the 2025-2026 school year. Please read the attached information.

PARKING PASSES WILL GO ON SALE STARTING ON:

SENIORS ONLY: MONDAY, JULY 21, TUESDAY, JULY 22, & WEDNESDAY, JULY 23

SENIORS AND JUNIORS: MONDAY, JULY 28, TUESDAY, JULY 29 AND WEDNESDAY, JULY 30

SCHEDULED TIMES: 8:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. & 1:00 p.m. – 2:30 p.m.

PASSES WILL CONTINUE TO BE SOLD THROUGHOUT THE SCHOOL YEAR OR UNTIL THEY ARE SOLD OUT.

Parking fee for BOTH Semesters is \$50.00. If the student pays the \$20.00 Activity Fee, he/she can choose the \$20.00 off parking discount option and pay \$30.00 for the school year. This **MUST** be paid when purchasing the pass. No refunds will be issued after parking is paid. **If you choose this option, payment may ONLY be made in the form of CASH OR BY CHECK, MADE PAYABLE TO: Springstead H.S.** You may also choose the option to pay for parking via RevTrak, however, the \$50.00 payment can only be applied to the parking option only.

1. **JUNIORS & SENIORS ONLY must have a GPA of 2.0 or above with 12+ credits.** Spots will be sold on a first come, first serve basis, until they are sold out. 10th graders, who request a parking spot and meet requirements, will be put on a waiting list. FRESHMEN ARE NOT ELIGIBLE.
2. **Notes of Obligation MUST be cleared and/or paid before purchasing a parking permit.** Outstanding fees must be paid and/or books returned. Payment may be made in the form of cash or by check, made payable to Springstead H.S., at the time of purchase. Please contact Mrs. Loughran at X: 407 to check if you have any obligations.
3. **Copies of the student's Florida driver's license (NO learner's permit), registration and automobile insurance for ALL vehicles listed, must be attached.** Paperwork must be completed, signed by a parent or guardian and **NOTARIZED.** A notary is available at your bank. **Incomplete applications and expired documents will not be accepted.**
4. Changes to vehicles or information must be added to the original application. Student must bring in a copy of the new registration and insurance card **BEFORE** driving on campus. Assigned tag may be used for additional vehicles listed.
5. If a vehicle is parked in your assigned spot, please take a picture of the back of the car, including the license plate, make and model of the car, and give the information to Mrs. Loughran. She will forward the information to Mr. Beach/Deputy/Guardian.

1. **ATTACH CURRENT COPIES OF STUDENT'S DRIVER'S LICENSE, VEHICLE REGISTRATION & AUTO INSURANCE FOR ALL VEHICLES LISTED. EXPIRED DOCUMENTS OR INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED!**
2. **PARKING FEE - \$50.00 per year. If student pays the \$20.00 Activity Fee, \$20.00 will be applied to the Activity Fee & \$30.00 will be applied to the Parking Fee.**
3. **Notes of Obligation MUST be paid &/or books returned prior to purchasing parking pass.**
4. **PARENT SIGNATURE MUST BE NOTARIZED - Entire form must be completed.**
5. **PARKING TAGS ARE NON-TRANSFERRABLE!!!**
6. **GPA of at least a 2.0 & a 12 Credit minimum is REQUIRED.**
7. **JUNIORS & SENIORS only! (NO parking for 9th graders) 10th graders will be put on a waiting list if they meet the requirements.**
8. **PAYMENT may be made in the form of CASH or CHECK, made payable to: Springstead H.S.**

PARKING RULES:

1. Parking tags are to be hung on the rear view mirror of your vehicle with the number facing outward.
2. Students are **NOT** permitted to leave campus in his/her vehicle at any time during the school day without administrative permission.
3. Students are **NOT** permitted to leave campus alone, or with other students for lunch.
4. Vehicle will **ONLY** be parked in student designated parking lots. Any vehicle improperly parked or not properly displaying a valid parking tag may be **fin**~~ed~~**ed or towed** at the student's and/or parent/guardian's expense, and/or the student will receive 2 to 5 days of in school suspension.
5. **Personal Search:** Students and their vehicles may also be searched by the school principal or designee if the school official has reason to believe that the health and safety of that student or other students in the school are in jeopardy, or the student is in possession of items prohibited at schools.
6. **Permission for parking may be RESCINDED/or REVOKED at any time during the school year for:**
 - a. **5 or more unexcused absences per term**
 - b. **Failure to maintain a minimum of 2.0 GPA**
 - c. **No more than 2 – Level 3 disciplines per semester**
 - d. **Attendance falls below the required 90% rate**
7. Upon arrival to school, students are expected to exit their vehicle. **NO loitering in parking lots.**
8. Students shall **NOT** move their vehicle until the busses leave the bus loop during afternoon dismissal.

PARENT & TEEN SAFE DRIVING AGREEMENT

Hernando County promotes the safety of their students while operating motor vehicles. Driving is a privilege and a conversation between parent/guardian and student about **IMPAIRED DRIVING** could make a difference.

In 2018, NHTSA (National Highway Traffic and Safety Administration) launched its **IF YOU FEEL DIFFERENT YOU DRIVE DIFFERENT** campaign to educate about the dangers of driving while impaired by drugs, and to promote safer choices. Any time you consume a substance that makes you feel different, you aren't safe to drive. **IMPAIRED DRIVING ISN'T A MISTAKE; IT'S A CRIME.**

Parents, make sure your young driver is aware of the leading causes of teen crashes.

Have a conversation about the following:

1. Driver inexperience (most insurance companies consider a "new driver" to be until 25 years old)
2. Nighttime driving (extra nighttime driving practice with your teen)
3. Not using seat belts (Florida law requires all drivers and passengers, front and back seat, to wear a safety belt)
4. Distracted driving (electronic devices, eating, emotional/upset)
5. Drowsy driving (sleep is often the first thing to go with a teen's busy schedule, teens should average 9 hours of sleep a night)
6. Reckless driving (lack of skills, lack of experience, distractions)
7. Driving under the influence (includes but not limited to: alcohol, marijuana, drugs, sleep aids, Rx side effects, cough medicine, household chemicals)
