Caring for students close to home.

Where:

The new Montezuma-Cortez High School has an on-site *School-Based Health Center*.

Why:

To provide access to comprehensive primary and behavioral healthcare in a convenient, inviting environment.



Who:

ANY STUDENT enrolled in a Montezuma - Cortez RE-1 school who is between the ages of 3 and 21 is eligible to receive medical care. *You do not have to be a student at MCHS to receive treatment.*

Cost:

No charge for visits to the nurse. Insurance will be billed for a provider visit. If you do not have insurance an enrollment specialist will help you. Care will be provided regardless of insurance status or ability to pay. Sports physicals are available for \$31.

How:

A parent or guardian must provide a signed consent for their student.
