

MEDICAID REIMBURSEMENT

- The program is a process of reimbursement of up to 50% of the costs to provide services to Medicaid eligible students on an IEP (Individual Education Plan.)
- The reimbursement we receive is used to fund the nursing program and to lessen the time that secretaries have to attend to nursing issues.
- The funds have previously covered paraprofessionals who provide health needs and counseling services but due to the tightening of the program, these costs are no longer able to be covered by the reimbursement.
- Centennial Billing Solutions is the company which processes the paperwork to receive reimbursement.
- A “Medicaid Eligibility Form” is part of your building level enrollment packet.
 - Please submit these completed forms to Leilani Scott, ESS Director as you receive them at the beginning of the year and throughout.
- A new system called RMTS (Random Moment Time Study) has been started that is part of the new reporting process.
- You may be receiving a call from Billye requesting help with your staff to complete a RMTS moment.
 - This is an e-mail sent directly to the service provider (teacher or para) asking them what they were doing at a specific moment of time.
 - The email comes from “State of Colorado Time Study (cortms@pcgus.com)”.
 - These e-mails have to be answered within 5 days (120 hours) after the specific moment passes.
- As the restrictions get tighter and tighter, as with any governmental program, we are receiving less and less reimbursement funds for more paperwork and details required.
