Dear Parents, Students, Staff and Community Members,

At the direction of Oregon's Governor Kate Brown and the Oregon Department of Education and in response to the COVID-19 public health crisis, the Butte Falls School District has closed Butte Falls Charter School, effective 4:00 p.m. today. **Classes will resume on Wednesday, April 1.** We plan to use the extended break to do spring cleaning and prepare our school for safe operation for the rest of the school year.

All extracurricular activities, sports, and other programming will be suspended until April 1. The District will continue to monitor the situation closely with guidance from the Oregon Health Authority and Jackson County Public Health. Any new information will be communicated to students, parents, and community members when it is available.

The District encourages students and their families to stay engaged academically during this time off. We encourage parents to read with their Pre-K and elementary school children.

We understand the hardship this decision may cause for many of our families and staff. Please know that the health and safety of our staff, students and their families remain our top priority.
