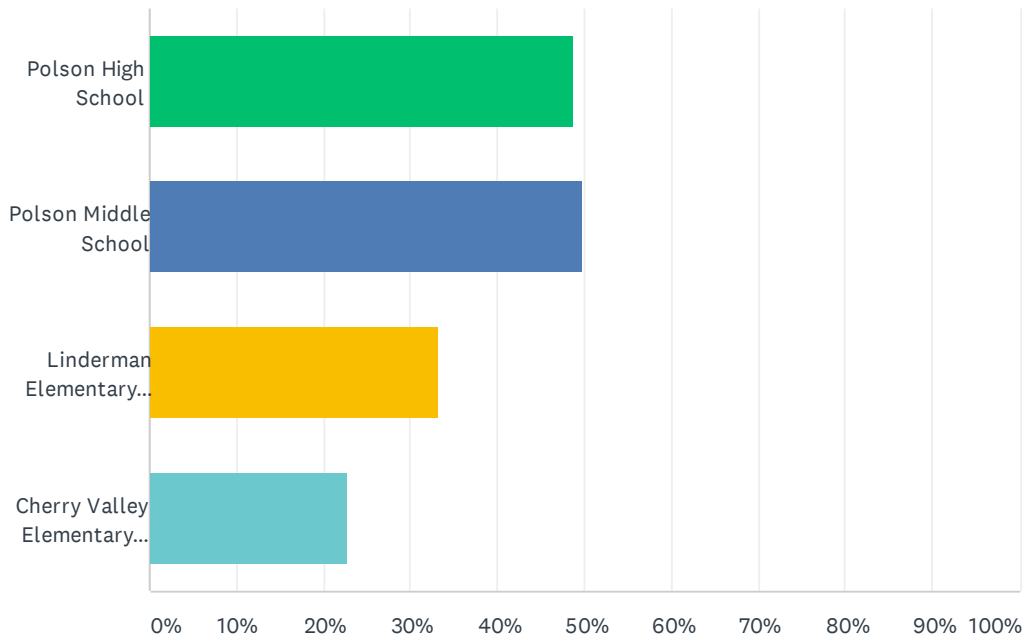


Q1 Which school/schools does your child(ren) attend? Please mark all that apply.

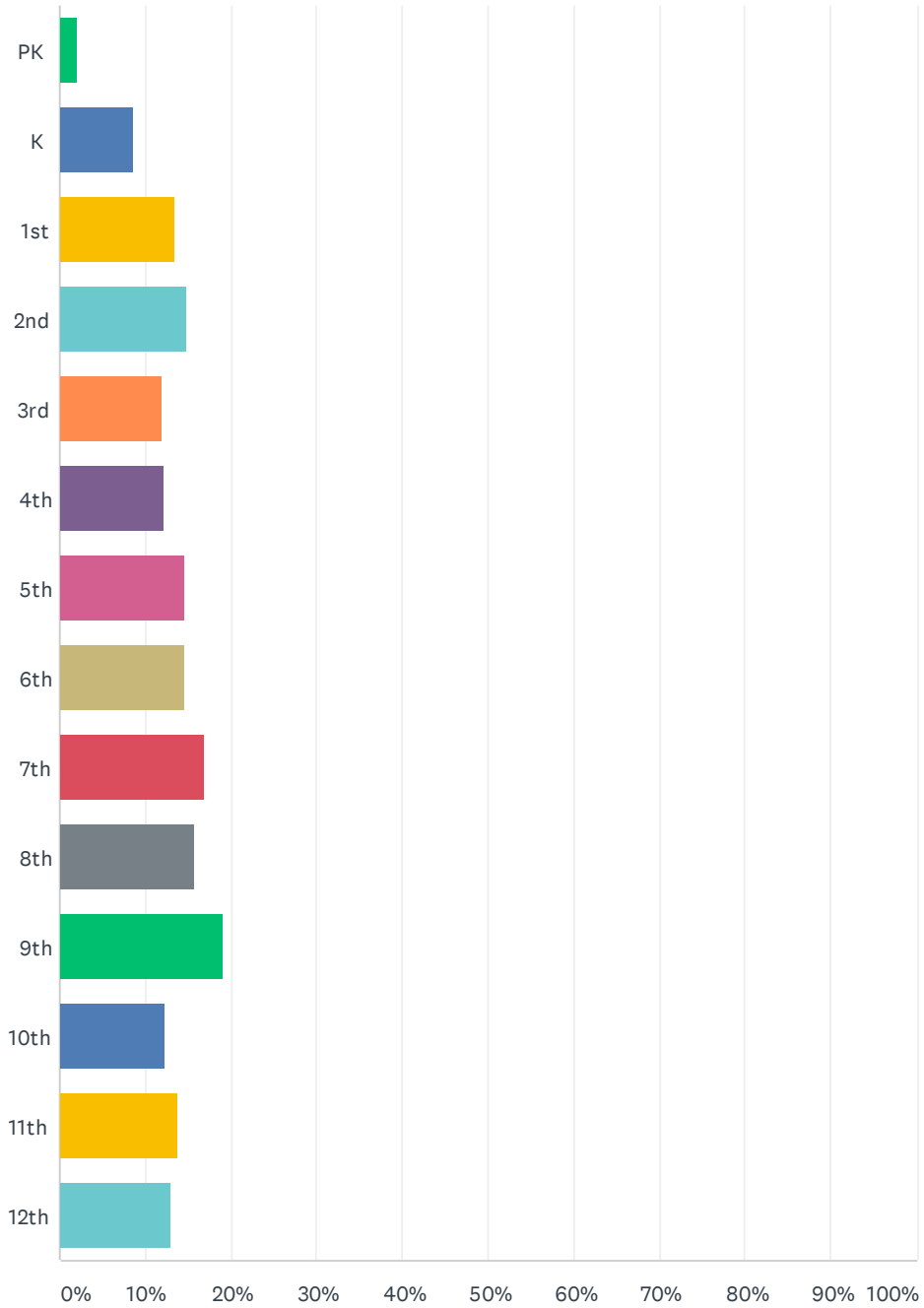

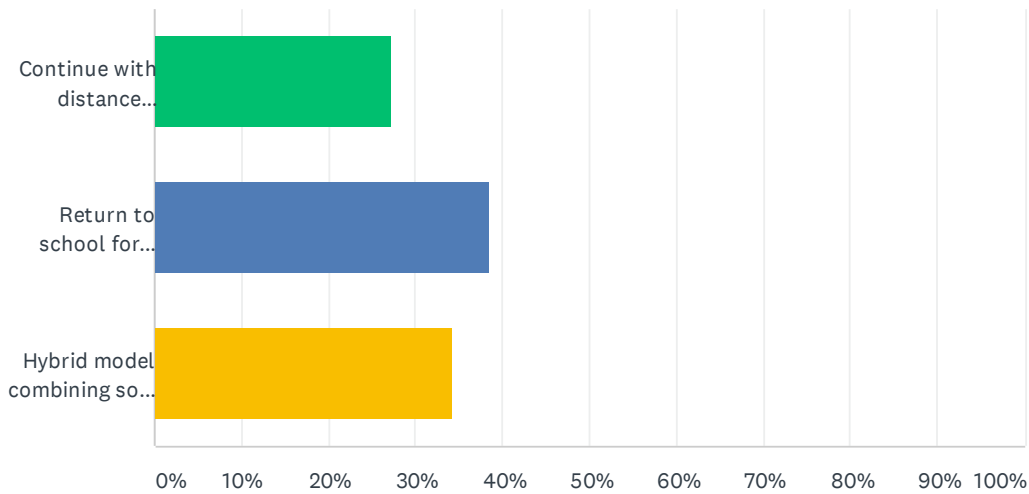

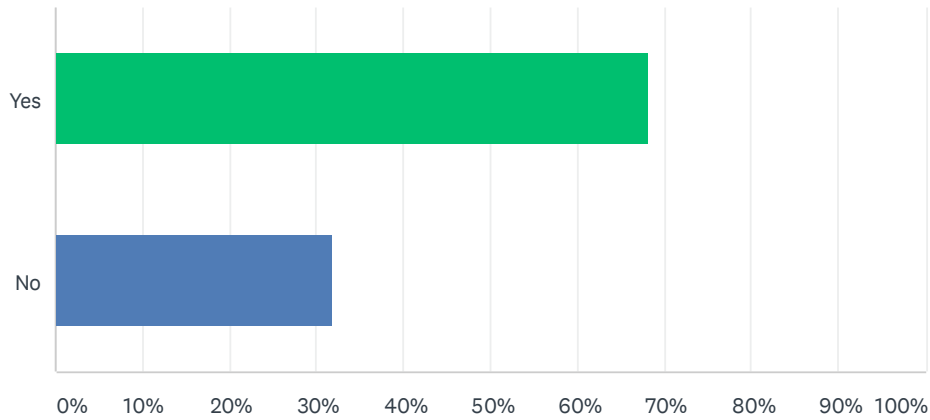

Q4 If schools reopen in Phase II pursuant to state and county health department guidelines, will your child(ren) return to in-class (in-person) instruction in the fall of 2020?

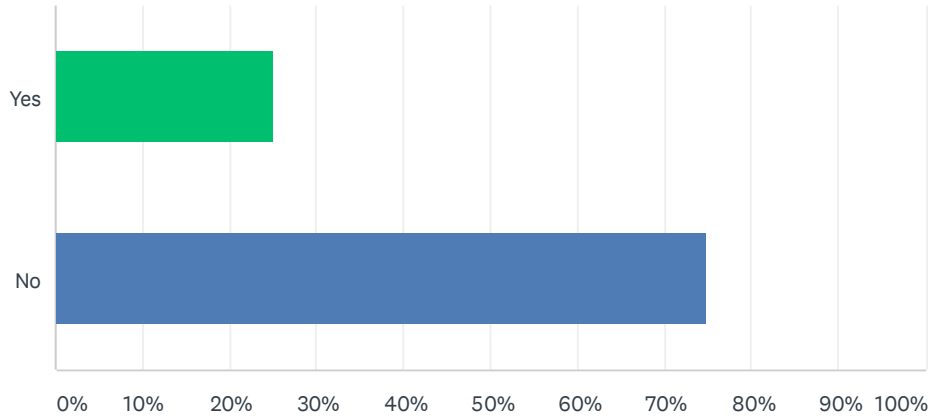

Q5 Will your child(ren) require bus transportation?

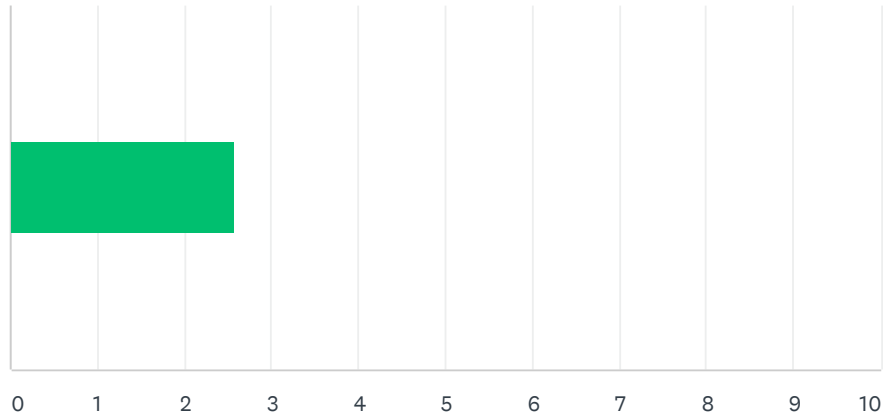

Q6 Overall, given that remote learning was unexpectedly imposed, how was your child's experience last year with remote learning?

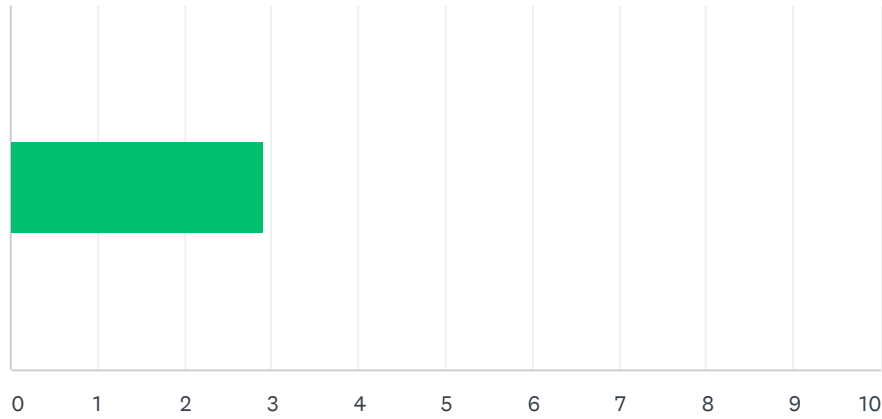

Q7 How would you describe the amount of schoolwork assigned by your child's teacher during last year's remote learning time?

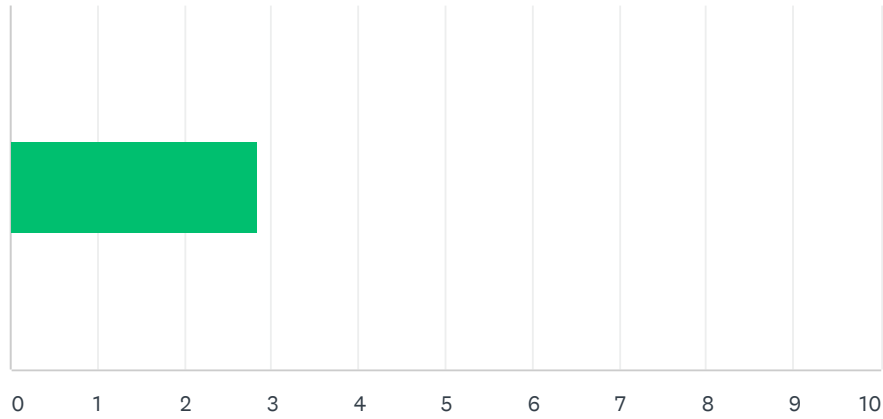

Q8 How clear was the communication from your child's school during last year's school closure and remote learning?

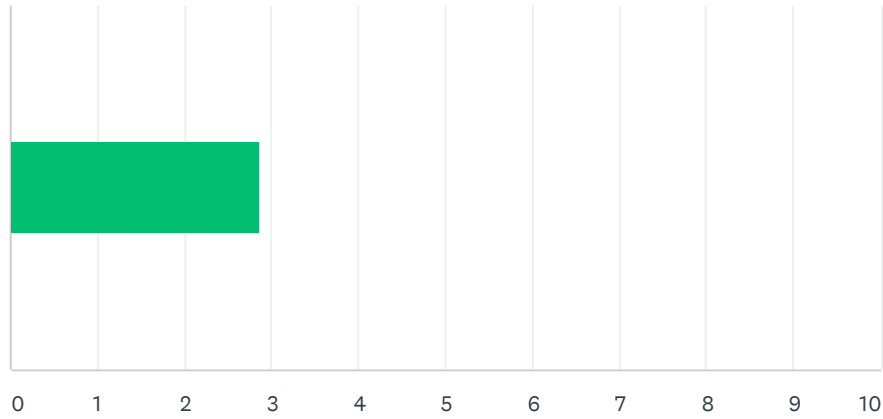

Q9 If the District continues with a distance learning model, how prepared do you feel to make distance learning successful in your home?

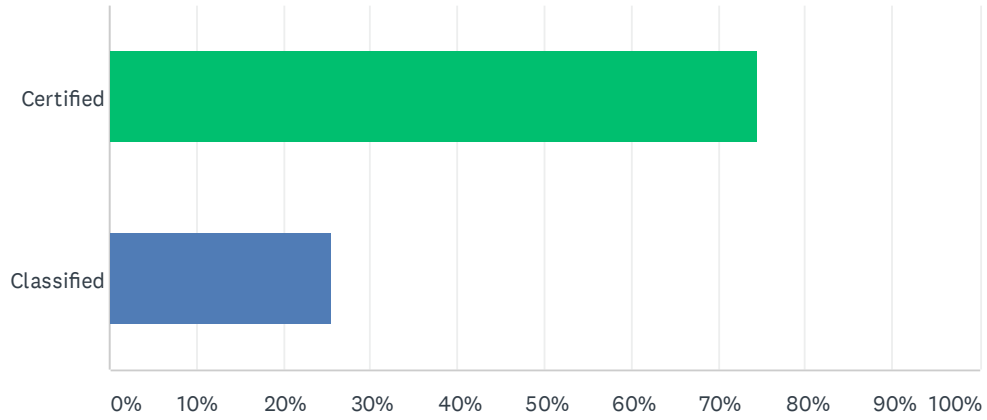

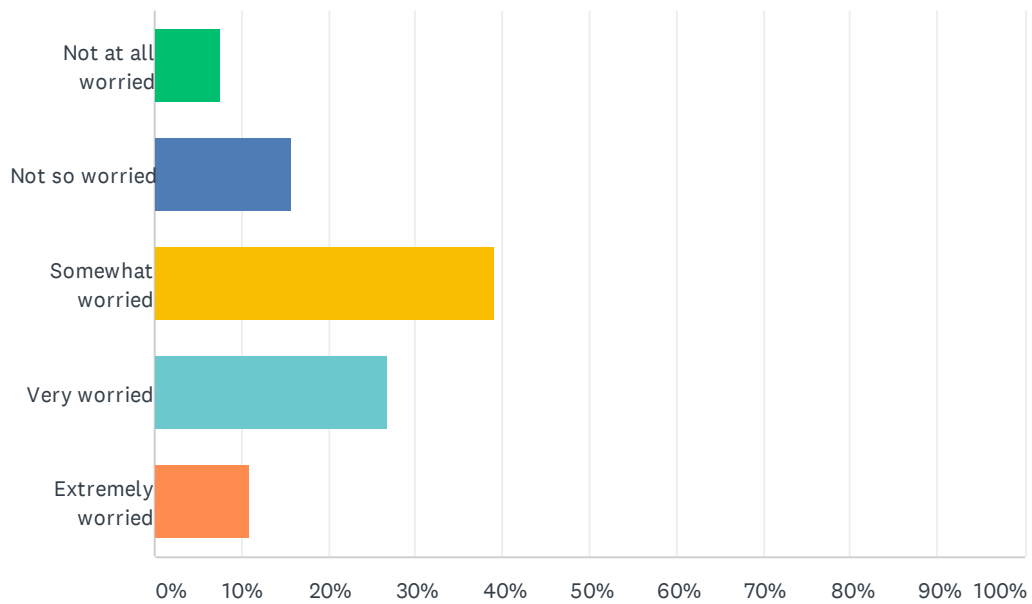

Q2 How worried are you about the impact of coronavirus on you personally?

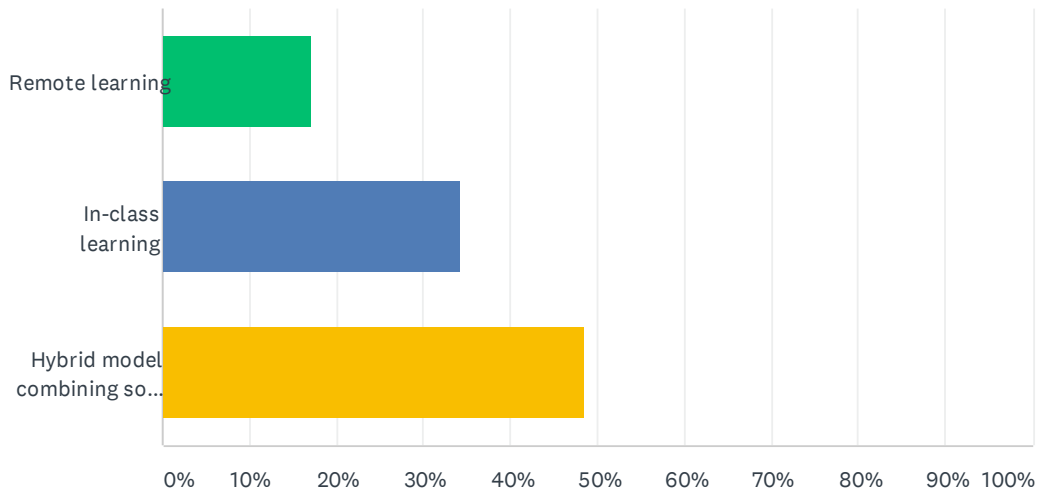

Q3 Would you prefer we continue with distance learning or return to school for in-class learning?

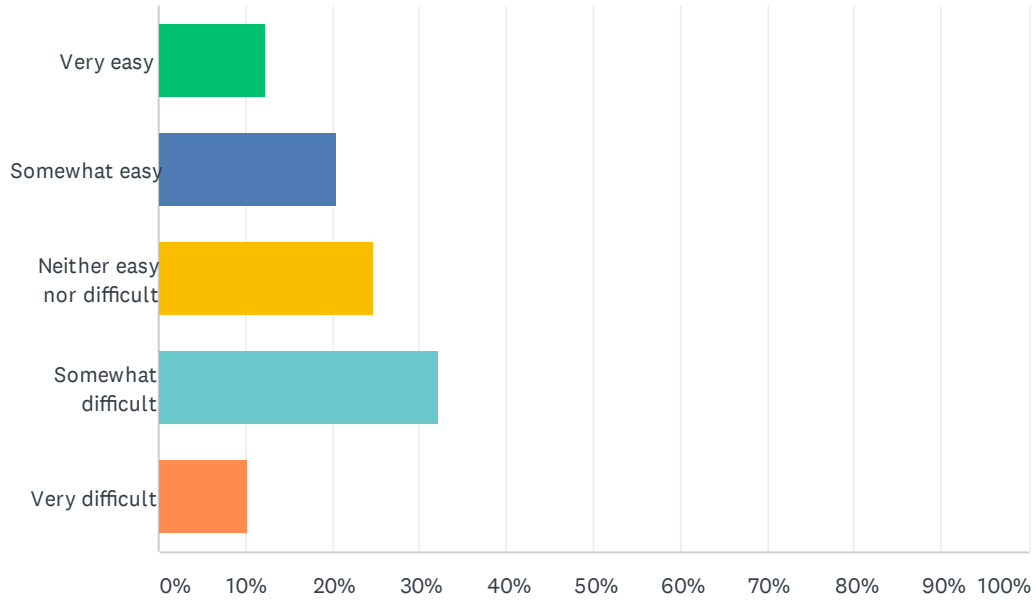

Q4 How easy or difficult was it for you to work remotely?

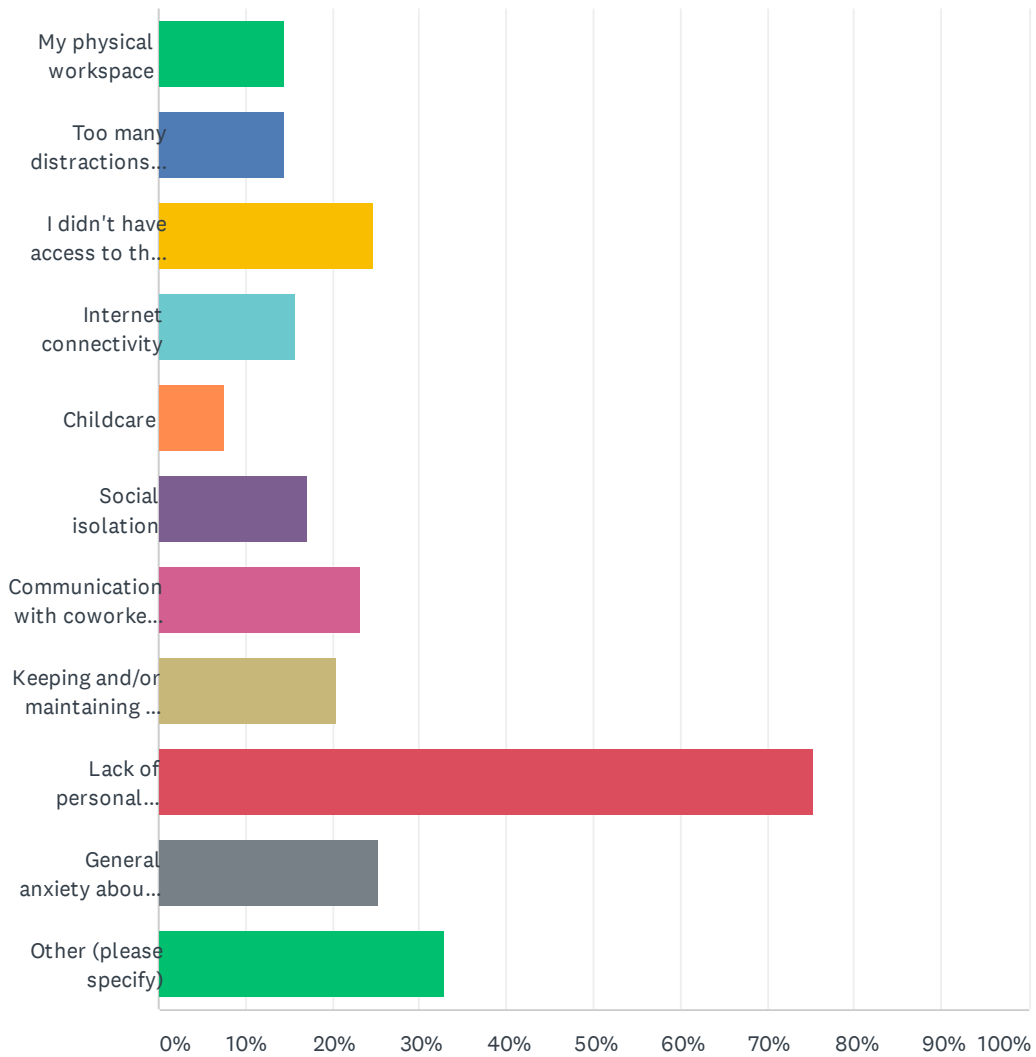

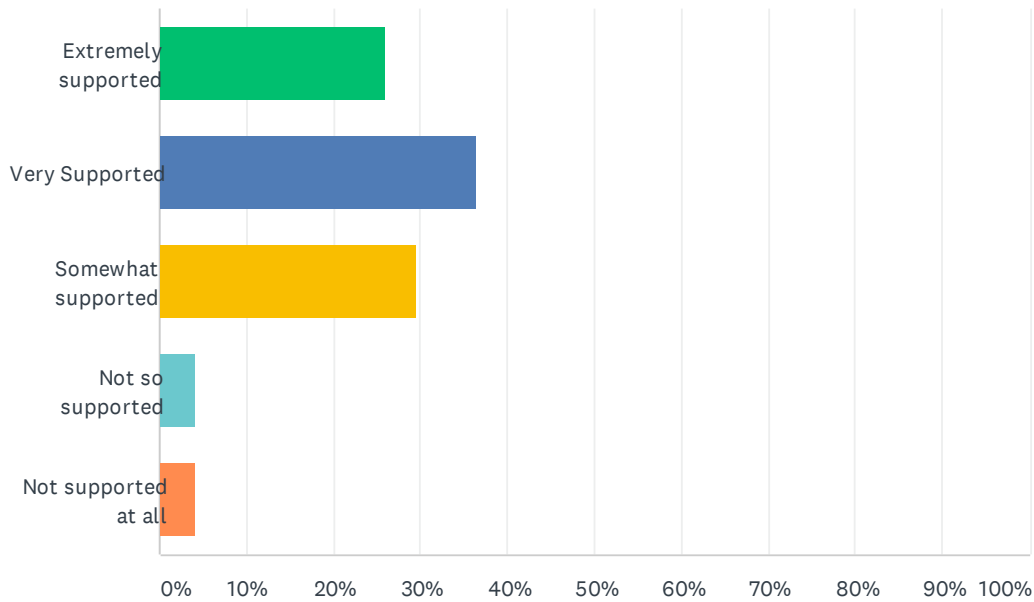

Q6 How supported by your building supervisor and/or direct supervisor did you feel during the school closure and/or distance learning time?

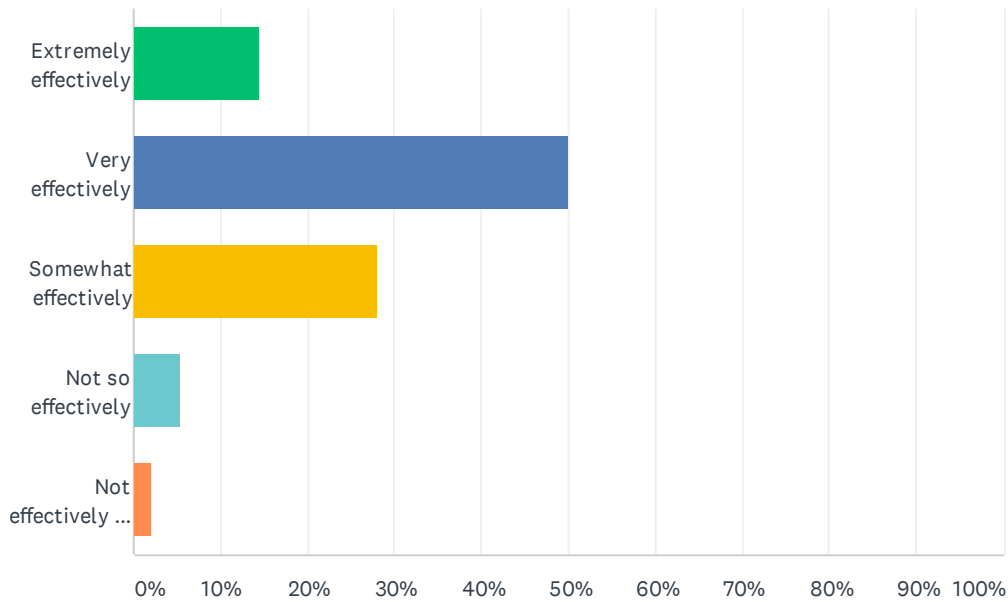
