CPR & First Aid Certification FAQs

1. Understand the benefits of CPR and First Aid

CPR and first-aid training will teach you the following:

- a. How to check the scene of the emergency.
- b. How to determine the needs of a victim.
- c. When to call 911
- d. First-aid skills for controlling bleeding and treating cuts, scrapes, bee stings, insect or snake bites, etc.
- e. The signs and symptoms of a heart attack, choking, etc.
- f. How to treat sudden illnesses.

2. Find a CPR and first-aid course

You can find either online or in-person courses in most areas. Many local hospitals and community centers offer programs or can point you in the right direction. You can also find safety training courses through the websites of the American Red Cross, the American Heart Association and the National Safety Council.

There are a variety of courses, aimed at helping both adult and child victims. There are classes ranging from 30-minute citizen CPR sessions to blended learning courses, to a full first-aid, CPR and AED (Automated External Defibrillator) course.

- ❖ *Keep in mind, CPR & First Aid are required in order to Volunteer or Chaperone at Desert Heights Charter Schools.*

Fingerprint Clearance Card Application FAQs

All applicants must register prior to being fingerprinted. You must be fingerprinted within 90 days of registration.

1. The applicant must register with Gemalto Cogent at www.aps.gemalto.com. Choose Arizona and then click *Register Online for a Background Check*.
 2. After registration is complete, the applicant will receive a **Registration ID Number**.
 3. While onlineregistration (www.aps.gemalto.com) is the preferred registration method, telephone registration is also available: 1-877-99NMAPS (1-877-996-6277).
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- ❖ Wear a mask
 - ❖ Minimal fingerprint locations are open, please check locations before registering.
