

# Graduation Requirements

## Coursework

Students must successfully complete a minimum of 23 credits to graduate from Sheboygan Falls High School.

### English (4 credits)

1. English 9– 1 credit
2. English 10 – 1 credit
3. English 11 or AP English Language – 1 credit
4. English 12 or AP English Literature– 1 credit

### Mathematics (3 credits)

Sheboygan Falls School District requires all students to graduate with math proficiency through Algebra 2. Students must complete one course from each of the following:

1. Algebra 1– 1 credit
2. Geometry, STEM Geometry– 1 credit
3. Algebra 2, Algebra 2/Trig– 1 credit

### Science (3 credits)

1. Science 9 A & B – 1 credit
2. Biology A & B – 1 credit
3. One (1) additional Science credit

### Social Studies (3 credits)

1. US History – 1 credit
2. Global Studies – 1 credit
3. Government & Politics - .5 credit
4. Economics - .5 credit

### Physical Education (1.5—2.0 credits) (2.0—Class of 2022 and beyond includes Health)

1. Physical Education 9 and 2 additional PE courses– .5 credit each
2. Health Education .5 credit—starting with the class of 2022—must be taken in 9, 10, or 11 grade

### Minimum Course Load

Each student is required to take and maintain a minimum of 3 credits during each semester to maintain status as a high school student. A student may request a waiver from the minimum enrollment requirements, if the student or parents believe there is substantial reason for waiver. Requests for waiver of the minimum enrollment standard shall be presented to the high school principal, or his/her designee, and shall clearly state the reason (s) for requesting such waiver. The principal, or designee, shall render a decision in a timely manner and indicate the reason (s) for approval or denial of the waiver requested.
