

Service Learning Opportunities

Volunteer Community Service

Grades: 9-12
Prerequisites: Member of Community Service Club
Credit: 0.5 for 150 hours of community service over four years

The Volunteer Community Service Club of Sheboygan Falls High School is designed to teach students how to be productive through helping others. It serves as a learning experience through which our students can shape their lives and become part of a caring community. Students will learn the importance of volunteerism to the individual, family, school, agencies and society.

To log hours and be eligible for .5 credit, students must be members of the club. Students may choose to participate in service learning opportunities offered by the club adviser or they may choose their own service learning opportunities. Students are expected to keep a log of their activities, make a copy for their records and hand the master sheets in on a timely basis.

Key Club

Grades: 9-12
Prerequisites: none
Credit: If a concurrent member of Community Service Club for 0.5 for 150 hours of community service over four years

Key Club is an international student-led organization which provides its members with opportunities to provide service, build character, and develop leadership through community and school related service projects. Many activity projects are coordinated with the local Sheboygan Falls Kiwanis club. Dues are \$13. These dues pay the National and State Key Club dues.
