

Work Release

<i>Grade:</i>	<i>12</i>
<i>Prerequisite:</i>	<i>Employment and an interview with your counselor</i>
<i>Course Length:</i>	<i>One semester (may be taken both semesters)</i>
<i>Course Hrs/Credit:</i>	<i>One or Two class hours/0.25 credit per class hour</i>

The work release is intended for an individual interested in earning credit for their work experience at a job of their choosing. The student can be released from school one or two class hours each day. This opportunity will be graded on a pass/fail basis. The student must:

- be employed approximately 10 hours per week for each class hour credit earned,
- hand in at least 3 pay stubs to his/her counselor during the semester,
- be in good academic standing the semester prior to work release and during work release,
- maintain a good attendance record (less than 10 absences) and behavioral record, and
- continue employment throughout the semester.

Note: If a student is taking a full load of classes and working part-time, he/she may use this program to earn additional credits.
