Parent/Child Swim Program

The Sheboygan Falls Aquatic Center provides swim lessons to children as young as 1 year of age.

The American Red Cross Parent and Child Aquatic program helps young children become comfortable in and around the water so they are ready to learn to swim. The program is not designed to teach children to become good swimmers or even to survive in the water on their own. The Parent and Child Aquatic program gives parents information and techniques to help orient their children to the water and to supervise water activities safely.

There are no skill prerequisites for Parent and Child Aquatics. A child must be at least 1 year old to enroll in the Parent and Child class. A parent or other caregiver is required to accompany each child in the water and participate in the classes.

Parent and Child Aquatic Levels

Level A: For children who

- Are 1 to 2 years old and have little water experience or one previous session of water adjustment lessons.

Level B: For children who

- Are 18 months to 4 years old and have had two or more previous sessions of water adjustment lessons, submerge only reluctantly (or not at all) or require flotation support at all times.
- Are up to 5 years old and have little or no previous experience in water adjustment lessons, are reluctant to enter the water or submerge, requires flotation support at all times or may benefit from parental presence and support in the water.

Course Length

Parent/Child Aquatic classes are scheduled to meet 8 times with classes lasting 30 minutes.
