All plans and materials will be provided. This opportunity will begin with students in October 2019 and run through January 2020. Must be willing to meet with students after school for two (2) hours per week for 12 weeks + additional hours (1) Saturday in December for the competition and (1) Friday in March for the Regional Robotic tournament at RPI. There will be at least 5 teams this pilot year. More details about the program will be explained in late June once all LEGO Team leaders have been hired. This is not a shared position – one teacher must commit to this project for the course of 12 weeks.
