Program

Virtual Summer School is an accredited program offering secondary level instruction for all students in the City of Albany.

Attendance

Students are required to participate in Google Classroom forums at least twice per week.

Grading: pass/fail

Grades for students registered for classes on Google Classroom will be based on a minimum of eight assignments in addition to weekly online participation. Grades for students registered for classes on APEX must earn a minimum of 65 to earn course credit.

Technology

Current AHS students will use district-issued Chromebooks (one per family) and hotspots (as needed). Students who reside in the City of Albany but attend a charter, private or parochial school are responsible for meeting their own technology needs. Regents exams

As per the executive order issued by Governor Cuomo, there will be no Regents exams this summer.
