

SAU 21 School Closure Information and Resources

Good Evening, please read carefully regarding meal distribution information, no-cost wifi options, and distance learning resources.

Meal Distribution Pickup and Delivery Information [Repeated Information]

We continue to provide meals for all SAU 21 students at Seabrook Elementary School and Winnacunnet High School. Breakfast and lunch pick up is available on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 9:00am-10:00am at both locations. Two days of meals will be provided for each student on each distribution day. Families from any District may pick up meals at either location on any given distribution day. No sign-up is required to receive meals.

Please note that families do not have to qualify for free/reduced lunch to participate in the meal distribution. We would like as much participation in the meal distribution program as possible.

SAU 21 is also delivering meals during distribution days. You may meet the bus at any stop to receive meals as you do not have to sign up for pick up or delivery of meals.

Xfinity WiFi Free For Everyone: Xfinity WiFi hotspots located in businesses and outdoor locations across the country will be available to anyone who needs them for free – including non-Xfinity Internet subscribers. Atlantic Broadband Until further notice Atlantic Broadband's WiFi hotspots are open to the public. Both customers and non Atlantic Broadband subscribers can access our public hotspots. Simply visit one of the locations on the map and connect to "AtlanticBB WiFi" on your device's WiFi network settings.

Hotspots via your Cell Carrier

AT&T: From mid-march through mid-may, AT&T will be waiving all overage charges on domestic mobile data, voice and text, keeping wireless Internet and phone service on and waiving late payment fees, expanding eligibility for limited income households to access from AT&T, suspending Home Internet usage caps, keeping our public Wi-Fi hotspots open for anyone who needs them. <https://www.att.com/help/covid-19/>. Comcast Internet Essentials

This program is available for families that receive State assistance or have a student that receives Free or Reduced school lunch. To sign up, applicants can simply visit www.internetessentials.com. The accessible website also includes the option to video chat with customer service agents in American Sign Language. There are also two dedicated phone numbers 1-855-846-8376 for English and 1-855-765-6995 for Spanish. New customers will receive 60 days of complimentary Internet Essentials service, which is normally available to all qualified low-income households for \$9.95/month.
