Dear Seabrook Middle School Parents and Guardians,

I hope this letter finds you well and enjoying some summer. We have been working hard all summer on plans for our students. Up until this point you should have received multiple communications from the SAU about plans to return to school. Going forward you can expect regular communication from me with details about our plans and important information you will need to have for your students. The school board recently approved the recommendation that Seabrook Middle School start the year with Enriched Virtual Learning. This means students will continue to do their schooling from home. This does not mean it will be the same as it was when we went remote in the spring. We learned a lot from the spring and have worked on many changes that we believe will help our students to be more successful. As we have more information I will be sending it, but here are a few of the changes you can expect to see related to your child's school day.

- A daily schedule similar to a typical school day that each student will follow. The day will begin at 8:00 am with RAM block (advisory) and be followed by three 90 minute class periods to include live instruction, independent work time, small group and individual instruction. The teacher is available to the student throughout the 90 minute block.
- Attendance is taken by class period and students will be expected to attend every class unless a parent or guardian calls them in sick.
- The block schedule allows students to only have to keep track of three class periods each day. There will be an A day and a B day that alternates with three classes each day.
- The Unified Arts team will join each grade level for one quarter and rotate so students only have to do one Unified Art at a time.

Supply lists will be sent out very soon. Our teachers are reviewing them and editing them to match needs for remote instruction.

New this year: Beginning of the year student re-registration will all be done online through the PowerSchool parent portal. All parents will have to create an account to do this online paperwork. More information on this will be forthcoming.

We will have a schedule for chromebook pick up and that will likely take place during the week of August 31st.
