Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

We are permitting your child to take a school-owned Chromebook home to avoid interruption in their studies. Please read the rules below, sign, and return the permission slip in order to pick Chromebooks up.

- Your student will be responsible for taking care of the Chromebook and use it for educational purposes only. **Note:** Search history is not private and cannot be deleted.
- Seabrook School District will not assume responsibility for damaged, lost, or stolen items.

Before a Chromebook is assigned to a student to take home, the parent/guardian must assume financial responsibility for the Chromebook and the Chromebook charger by signing this permission form.

If the Chromebook has a failure of an internal part, it is covered by a warranty and will be repaired at no cost. If the Chromebook assigned to your child is lost, stolen, or damaged through negligence, or vandalism, you are responsible for the cost of repair or replacement.

Replacement cost for a Chromebook is approximately \$300. The most common reason for the need to replace a Chromebook is liquid damage. Liquid damage will be considered negligence. Replacement cost for a Chromebook power adapter is \$50.

Chromebooks and chargers must be returned to the school on the day the school is reopened and/or your child returns to school.

Guidelines:

- Chromebooks are loaned to students as an educational tool and are only authorized for use consistent with the school's mission.
- The Chromebook may only be used by the student to whom it is assigned.
- Parents/guardians have the right to their child's login password.
- Making changes in the configuration of the Chromebook is prohibited.
- If the Chromebook is lost or stolen while in the student's possession, a report must be filed immediately with the local police authorities and school administration.
- The Board's policy and rules concerning computer and Internet use ***and all other policies and rules*** apply to use of Chromebooks at any time or place, including away from school property.
- Chromebooks have been configured so that students may not download any additional software or programs.
- Securely search has been enabled to monitor content, but parents/guardians should periodically check search history. Deleting the search history is NOT allowed.
- Google Chrome is the preferred search engine. Students in grades 3-8 are required to log into their Google account when using the device.
