While this is far from ideal our staff are working hard to make the best of it. A big shout out to all of our staff, students and parents for their hard work and patience as we begin this out of the ordinary school year.

We have definitely had some technology glitches here and there, but we are here to help you work through them so please reach out with any issues you may have. Teachers are giving grace to students these first days of school as they navigate through a whole new schedule and set of expectations. A reminder that attendance is taken in each class and if students do not come to class and you have not called the school to say they will be absent a teacher will be reaching out to you. The following expectations for remote learning were reviewed with students this week:

- Follow school dress code
- Be on time
- Be in a quiet space with minimal distraction in the background (when possible)
- Be prepared (Charged computer, headphones if needed)



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- Camera is on and you are sitting upright
- Mute when you are not speaking or there is background noise
- Speak clearly, look up toward the camera

Important Note for Parents and Guardians: We appreciate all that you are doing to help your child be successful with this remote learning. It is ok to help get a Google Meet started, but adults and other household members cannot be in the class with the student. Due to the confidentiality of other students in the class please stay off of the camera and give your child space to be in class. Adults can certainly help and support their students outside of class time, but not during class. We recognize this can be a challenge, but we want the school experience to be as close to in person as possible. Please let me know if you have any questions or concerns.

PowerSchool Parent Portal: If you have not set up the Parent Portal, you will need to. Information went home in the folders handed out with chromebooks, but if you need assistance please reach out.
