



## Seabrook Middle School Weekly Communication



For those of you who have indicated that you would like your students to return to in person instruction the time is coming fast. Students are learning about what school will look like this week during RAM block. Feel free to ask them about it. Below are some important pieces of information for you to have. I will also be sending out my regular weekly communication on Thursday, but I wanted you to have this information as soon as possible.

- **Schedule: Beginning on January 11, 2021. The time for school will be 9:00 am to 2:30 pm on both in person and remote days. This is due to the buses needing to transport both elementary and middle school students on separate runs.**
  - Monday/Tuesday - grades 5 & 7
  - Thursday/Friday - grades 6 & 8
  - Every other Wednesday will be added
    - Grades 5 & 7 will come in on January 27th
    - Grades 5 - 8 will be remote February 3rd (due to district early release)
    - Grades 6 & 8 will come in on February 10th
    - They will alternate Wednesdays from there. I will be sure to keep the calendar up to date in my weekly emails.
    - Wednesdays will still follow an early release schedule.
- **Bus Routes:** The routes with times are attached to the email
- **Pick Up Patrol:** You will receive an email from Pick Up Patrol and will need to create an account. Every day prior to coming to school you will have to fill out the questions and if you answer no to all four questions your child will be clear to come to school. **\*\*\*Please help us by being vigilant about this. It is a must for students to be in class.**



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- **Masks:** Mask must be worn at all times unless on a mask break or eating breakfast or lunch. We will be providing students with time outside to get some fresh air and a break from mask wearing. If a student refuses to wear a mask he or she would be sent home.
- **Breakfast/Lunch:** All students will have the opportunity to eat breakfast and lunch at school each day. Both meals will happen in the classroom. Students will be able to grab breakfast on their way into school in the morning and lunch will be delivered to the classroom in the afternoon. Students may also choose to bring lunch from home. On Wednesdays students will be able to bring a bag lunch home with them as lunch time will not be provided at school due to the early release schedule. \*\*\* Please note that although all students are offered breakfast and lunch at this time it is very important that you still fill out the free and reduced lunch application if you have not already done so.
- **School Nurse:** Please see the letter attached from Nurse Sargent. Also attached is a nice flowchart for when to keep your child home.
- **School Supplies:** Each student will have their own bin at their desks for their supplies such as pencil, pen, eraser. Students are welcome to bring in their own supplies to keep at school. We will have supplies for those who need it. Other items students should bring:
  - Backpack - lockers will not be used so personal items will be kept at their desks.
  - Headphones to use in the classroom
  - Jacket/Coat/Sweatshirt - We will be going outside!
  - Chromebooks - make sure they are charged every night
